PROJECTS FUNDED FOR 2008-09**

- **BU-GATA** (Arlington) \$20,000 to support the tenant-led homeownership leadership structure in Buckingham Village
- **Buyers and Renters Arlington Voice** (Arlington) \$40,000 national grant to form a broad-based tenant association to speak for the rights of low-income renters
- **disAbility Resource Center** (Fredericksburg) \$20,000 to support teens and adults working with county planning boards and local schools to provide for the needs of people with disabilities
- **Fredericksburg Regional Head Start Parent Empowerment Project** \$10,000 for advocacy trips to give Head Start parents the opportunity to discuss health care, child care, insurance and educational issues with legislators
- **Hispanics Against Child Abuse and Neglect** (Fairfax) \$20,000 for the STAR program, which teaches leadership and advocacy skills to low-income teenage girls
- **HUMANCommunity** (Winchester) \$15,000 for community leadership program for Latinos
- **Progreso Hispano** (Alexandria) \$5,000 to increase the number of low-income participants on their board and to train the new members
- **Shirlington Employment and Education Center** (Arlington) \$10,000 to assist day laborers in establishing small businesses
- **Tenants & Workers United** (Woodbridge) \$10,000 local grant and \$45,000 national grant to fund organizers to build a multi-racial coalition to support immigrant rights in Prince William County
- **Virginians Organized for Interfaith Community Engagement (VOICE)** (Arlington, Alexandria, Fairfax and Prince William Counties) \$35,000 national grant to identify, train and develop leaders
